16	SEC. 16.93. ORGANIZATIONS FOR WHICH DEDUCTIONS CAN BE MADE.
17	Deductions and collections as provided by this Article V shall be made for the
18	organizations and the purposes designated in the following subsections:

20	(q) Bay Area Law Enforcement Assistance Fund, for the payment of money to.
21	(r) San Francisco Firefighter and EMS Behavioral Health Foundation, for the payment of
22	money to.

24	Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after
25	enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the

1	ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board	
2	of Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.

4	Section 3. Scope of Ordinance. In enacting this ordinance, the Board of Supervisors	
5	intends to amend only those words, phrases, paragraphs, subsections, sections, articles,	
6	numbers, punctuation marks, charts, diagrams, or any other constituent parts of the Municipal	
7	Code that are explicitly shown in this ordinance as additions, deletions, Board amendment	
8	additions, and Board amendment deletions in accordance with the "Note" that appears under	
9	the official title of the ordinance.
