12	Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:
13	
14	Section 1. Article VII of Chapter 20 of the Administrative Code is hereby amended by
15	revising Sections 20.7-3 and 20.7-14, to read as follows:
16	
17	SEC. 20.7-3. DEFINITIONS.
18	For the purposes of this <u>Article VIIordinance</u> :
19	* * * *
20	"Department" means the Department of Human Services of the City and County of
21	San Francisco.
22	"Discontinuance" means the termination of a person's entitlement to aid.
23	"Electronic benefit transfer" means a method of transferring benefits through a
24	centralized computer system so that an Applicant/participant may obtain his or her benefits at
25	facilities such as automated teller machines (ATM) and point-of-sale (POS) terminals using an

1	access device such as a magnetic stripe plastic card. "Electronic benefit transfer" includes
2	direct deposits.
3	"Executive Director" means the Executive Director of the Department of Human
4	Services of the City and County of San Francisco.
5	"Guaranteed Income Pilot Program" means an income distribution program that provides
6	unconditional, regular cash payments over a specified period of time to a specified participant
7	population, provided that the Department has approved the program's research and evaluation plan.
8	* * * *
9	SEC. 20.7-14. EXEMPT INCOME OR RESOURCES.
10	For the purpose of this Article VII, the following types of income and resources shall no
11	be considered available to the Applicant or Recipient in determining eligibility:
12	* * * *
13	(g) The portion of any student grants or loans that is paid directly to the educational
14	institution for tuition, fees, and/or books; and
15	(h) Payments made to the Applicant or Recipient as part of a locally-funded work
16	incentive program-: and
17	(i) Payments made to the Applicant or Recipient as a result of participation in a Guaranteed
18	Income Pilot Program, provided the Applicant or Recipient has not declared themselves to be
19	homeless, as set forth in Section 20.7-34 of this Article VII.
20	
21	Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after
22	enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the
23	ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board
24	of Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.

1	Section 3. Scope of Ordinance. In enacting this ordinance, the Board of Supervisors
2	intends to amend only those words, phrases, paragraphs, subsections, sections, articles,
3	numbers, punctuation marks, charts, diagrams, or any other constituent parts of the Municipal
4	Code that are explicitly shown in this ordinance as additions, deletions, Board amendment
5	additions, and Board amendment deletions in accordance with the "Note" that appears under
6	the official title of the ordinance.
