

1 [Accept and Expend Grant - Retroactive - Larkin Street Youth Services - Rising Up - Office of  
2 Financial Empowerment - \$181,368]

3 **Resolution retroactively authorizing the Office of the Treasurer and Tax Collector to**  
4 **accept and expend a grant increase in amount of \$65,000 for a total amount of \$181,368**  
5 **from Larkin Street Youth Services for the purpose of providing one-on-one financial**  
6 **coaching to Transitional Age Youth through the Rising Up campaign from July 1, 2023,**  
7 **through October 31, 2024.**

9 WHEREAS, The Rising Up campaign is a public-private partnership that includes six  
10 City departments, five non-profit organizations, several local companies, and a group of  
11 philanthropic supporters; and

12 WHEREAS, Larkin Street Youth Services is the anchor institution and fiscal sponsor of  
13 the Rising Up campaign, and the Department of Homelessness and Supportive Housing is the  
14 lead government agency; and

15 WHEREAS, The goal of Rising Up is to achieve a 50% reduction for homeless youth  
16 ages 18-24 by 2023 by helping Transitional Age Youth (TAY) with problem solving services to  
17 help them get long term financial support; and

18 WHEREAS, The Office of Financial Empowerment's Smart Money Coaching program  
19 empowers TAY to navigate the financial system so that they can make informed decisions and  
20 improve their financial lives; and

21 WHEREAS, Financial coaches help to identify the barriers that prevent TAY from  
22 accessing the financial mainstream and then outline clear and actionable steps to achieve  
23 resolutions so that TAY can strengthen their own financial capability; and

24 WHEREAS, The grant period is from July 1, 2023, through October 31, 2024; and

1 WHEREAS, The grant does not create any new positions, and will not require an  
2 amendment to the Annual Salary Ordinance; and

3 WHEREAS, A request for retroactive approval is being sought because the award  
4 agreement and increased funds were received on February 7, 2024 and immediately utilized to  
5 maintain services levels through the remainder of Fiscal Year 2023-2024; and

6 WHEREAS, The Office proposes to maximize use of available grant funds on  
7 program expenditures by not including indirect costs in the grant budget; now, therefore, be it

8 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Office of the  
9 Treasurer and Tax Collector to accept and expend the grant increase in the amount of \$65,000  
10 for a total amount of \$181,368 from Larkin Street Youth Services on behalf of the City and  
11 County of San Francisco; and, be it

12 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of  
13 indirect costs in the grant budget; and, be it

14 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Treasurer, or his  
15 designee, to enter into the agreement on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco; and,  
16 be it

17 FURTHER RESOLVED, That within thirty (30) days of the agreement being fully  
18 executed by all parties, the Office of the Treasurer and Tax Collector shall provide the final  
19 agreement to the Clerk of the Board for inclusion in the official file.
