AT&T Corporation, et al., San Francisco Superior Court, Case No. CGC-20-582552, with respect to U.S. Telepacific Corp., dba TPx Communications ("TPx"), by TPX's payment of \$3,660,000, TPXs's agreement to collect and remit access line taxes in a certain manner in the future unless there is a material change in the law, and mutual releases for past conduct and access line tax liability. The lawsuit involves allegations that the defendants knowingly under-collected and under-remitted amounts due under the Access Line Tax Ordinance in violation of the California False Claims Act.
