3	Motion appointing Sylvia Deporto (residency requirement waived), term ending April
4	29, 2018, to the Children and Families First Commission.

6	MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco does
7	hereby appoint the hereinafter designated person to serve as a member of the Children and
8	Families First Commission, pursuant to the provisions of Administrative Code, Section 86.1 et
9	seq., for the terms specified:
10	Sylvia Deporto (residency requirement waived), seat 2, succeeding Michele Rutherford,
11	shall be the General Manager of Human Services or his/her designee, for the unexpired
12	portion of a four-year term ending April 29, 2018.
13	FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors makes the following findings:
14	1. The membership of the Children and Families First Commission has a goal to be
15	representative of the diversity of the City and County of San Francisco.
16	2. Applicant Sylvia Deporto, who is not a resident of San Francisco, is a person with
17	experience that uniquely qualifies her to serve on the Children and Families First
18	Commission.
19	3. The Children and Families First Commission has attempted to fill the position, for
20	which Jennifer Garcia was nominated, with an individual who is a City resident and
21	who has the specific experience, skills, and qualifications, but has been unable to
22	do so at this time. The Rules Committee has certified that Sylvia Deporto is
23	qualified to serve on the Children and Families First Commission.
24	4. After exercising due diligence, the Board of Supervisors concludes that there is no

other possible representative, who is a resident of San Francisco, and who has the
