2 APPOINTING TWO MEMBERS TO THE LEAD HAZARD REDUCTION CITIZENS ADVISORY
3 COMMITTEE; WAIVING RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT.

5 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County
6 of San Francisco does hereby appoint the hereinafter designated
7 persons to serve as members of the Lead Hazard Reduction Citizens
8 Advisory Committee, pursuant to the provisions of the San Francisco
9 Health Code, Section 1608, for the term specified:

11 Peter Burns, succeeding James Hutchinson, (Seat No. 2, Must
12 represent the Department of Building Inspection), term expired, for a
13 new four-year term ending December 22, 2003.

15 Tim Carrico, succeeding himself, (Seat No. 9, Must be a
16 residential owner), unexpired portion of four-year term ending
17 December 22, 2000.

19 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors makes the
20 following findings:

22 1. The membership of the Lead Hazard Reduction Citizens Advisory
23 Committee has a goal to be representative of the diversity of
24 the City and County of San Francisco.

25 2. Applicant Peter Burns, a new appointee, who is not a resident
of San Francisco, is the representative of the Department of

1 uniquely qualifies him to serve on the Lead Hazard Reduction
2 Citizens Advisory Committee.

3 3. The Lead Hazard Reduction Citizens Advisory Committee has
4 attempted to fill the position, for which Peter Burns was
5 nominated, with an individual who is a City resident and who
6 has the specific experience, skills, and qualifications, but
7 has been unable to do so at this time. The Rules Committee
8 has certified that Peter Burns is qualified to serve on the
9 Lead Hazard Reduction Citizens Advisory Committee.

10 4. After exercising due diligence, the Board of Supervisors
11 concludes that there is no other possible representative, who
12 is a resident of San Francisco and who has the specific
13 experience, skills, or qualifications possessed by this
14 applicant, and who is willing to serve on the Lead Hazard
15 Reduction Citizens Advisory Committee at this time; and, be
16 it

17 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors waives the
18 residency requirement for Peter Burns, as allowed in cases where no
19 qualified City resident, willing to serve, can be found, pursuant to
20 Section 4.101 of the City Charter that requires persons appointed to
21 boards, commissions, and advisory bodies established by legislative
22 act of the Board of Supervisors to be residents of the City and
23 County of San Francisco.




