APPOINTING TWO MEMBERS TO THE LEAD HAZARD REDUCTION CITIZENS ADVISORY COMMITTEE; WAIVING RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT.

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco does hereby appoint the hereinafter designated persons to serve as members of the Lead Hazard Reduction Citizens Advisory Committee, pursuant to the provisions of the San Francisco Health Code, Section 1608, for the term specified:

Peter Burns, succeeding James Hutchinson, (Seat No. 2, Must represent the Department of Building Inspection), term expired, for a new four-year term ending December 22, 2003.

Tim Carrico, succeeding himself, (Seat No. 9, Must be a residential owner), unexpired portion of four-year term ending December 22, 2000.

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors makes the following findings:

- 1. The membership of the Lead Hazard Reduction Citizens Advisory Committee has a goal to be representative of the diversity of the City and County of San Francisco.
- 2. Applicant Peter Burns, a new appointee, who is not a resident of San Francisco, is the representative of the Department of

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors waives the residency requirement for Peter Burns, as allowed in cases where no qualified City resident, willing to serve, can be found, pursuant to Section 4.101 of the City Charter that requires persons appointed to boards, commissions, and advisory bodies established by legislative act of the Board of Supervisors to be residents of the City and County of San Francisco.
