2 EXTENDING CONDOLENCES TO THE EARTHQUAKE VICTIMS IN SOUTHERN MEXICO.

4 WHEREAS, An earthquake registering a magnitude of 7.5 shook  
5 southern Mexico on September 30, 1999; and,

6 WHEREAS, The earthquake sent hundreds and thousands of  
7 frightened people into the streets of cities and villages from the  
8 West Coast of Mexico to Mexico City; and,

9 WHEREAS, The Oaxaca state governor's office reported that 300  
10 houses and 100 businesses were seriously damaged by the earthquake;  
11 and,

12 WHEREAS, The earthquake damaged the important pre-Hispanic ruins  
13 of Monte Alban and other archeological sites in the state of Oaxaca;  
14 and

15 WHEREAS, At least 19 people died as a result of the earthquake  
16 in southern Mexico as reported by Tribune News Services; and,

17 WHEREAS, Earthquake victims included two women who were killed  
18 when their house crumbled on them, a man who was hit by falling  
19 debris as he ran from his office and a young girl who had a heart  
20 attack; and,

21 WHEREAS, San Francisco is deeply saddened by the loss of life  
22 and injuries caused by the recent earthquake; now, therefore, be it

23 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County  
24 of San Francisco extends condolences to the earthquake victims in  
25 southern Mexico; now, therefore, be it
