6 WHEREAS, The people of San Francisco and the San Francisco Board of Supervisors  
7 have repeatedly called for an end to the war in Iraq; and

9 WHEREAS, The Bush administration has made clear its intention to continue the  
10 occupation of Iraq throughout its tenure of office; and,

11 WHEREAS, The Iraq Moratorium aims to revive the anti-Iraq War movement by  
12 involving millions of people in protesting the war by a variety of nonviolent actions including  
13 vigils, teach-ins, religious services, lobbying and the wearing of black armbands; and,

14 RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors endorses the Iraq  
15 Moratorium's demands to Stop the War and Bring the Troops Home, as well as its program of  
16 a monthly series of actions demanding an end to the war, commencing Friday, September  
17 21st and continuing the Third Friday of every month thereafter, and further encourages all  
18 San Franciscans to become involved in this effort.


