2	partially reimburses DPH for one existing position, one Health Program Coordinator III (Job

6	receive the approval of the final grant agreement until October 15, 2015, for a project start		
7	date of October 10, 2015; and

10	RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and expend a gran
