2	Resolution recognizing International Day Against Homophobia and Transphobia and
3	calling upon City officials to lower the American and United Nations Flags in United
4	Nations Plaza for a 24-hour period on May 17, 2012.

6	WHEREAS, International Day Against Homophobia and Transphobia (IDAHO) is
7	celebrated each year on May 17 th , marking the day that the World Health Organization
8	removed homosexuality from its list of mental illnesses in 1990; and
9	WHEREAS, IDAHO is a rallying event taking place across the world that offers an
10 11	opportunity for people, regardless of their sexual orientation, to counter homophobia and
12	transphobia and demonstrate their solidarity with the Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, and
13	Transgender (LGBT) communities; and
14	WHEREAS, LGBT people across the world continue to face discrimination, violence,
15	and even death because of their sexual orientation; and
16	WHEREAS, Several nations have officially recognized IDAHO, including the
17	governments of Spain, Belgium, the United Kingdom, Mexico, Costa Rica, the Netherlands,
18	France, Luxemburg, and Brazil as well as several local governments including the Province of
19	Quebec and the City of Buenos Aires; and
20	WHEREAS, a main objective of IDAHO is to provoke action across the world to fight
21	against homophobia and transphobia using local strategies that correspond to the given cultural, political, and historical context of the place; and
22	WHEREAS, San Francisco has an international reputation as a beacon of hope, love,
23	and acceptance for LGBT people around the world; now, therefore, be it
