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Motion adopting findings related to the appeal of the decision of the Director of Public Works approving a Tentative/Parcel Map to create two new condominium units on Lot 11, Assessor's Block 6501, at 66-68 Fountain Street.

[Findings – Subdivision Map Appeal for 66-68 Fountain Street]

The appellant, Jerry Regan, filed a timely appeal on September 27, 2000, protesting the September 22, 2000, approval by the Director of Public Works of a Tentative/Parcel Map which creates two new condominium units on the property located at 66-68 Fountain Street.

The public hearing before the Board of Supervisors on said appeal was scheduled for November 6, 2000. On November 6, 2000, the Board of Supervisors conducted a duly noticed hearing on the appeal from the approval of the Tentative/Parcel Map.

In reviewing the appeal of the approval of the requested Tentative/Parcel Map, the Board of Supervisors reviewed and considered the written record before the Board and all of the public comments made in support of and opposed to the appeal.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco hereby finds that:

- The proposed Tentative/Parcel Map is exempt from environmental review per Class 1 California Environmental Quality Act Guidelines.
- The proposed Subdivision is consistent with the General Plan and with the Priority Policies of City Planning Code Section 101.1. The Subdivision is compatible with the objectives, policies, general land uses, and programs specified in the General Plan.
- The Map conforms to the technical requirements of the San Francisco
 Subdivision Code and the State Subdivision Map Act with respect to form and content.

4. No basis exists under Government Code Sections 66473.5 or 66474 to deny the Tentative/Parcel Map, based on the information before the Board.

FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors, on November 6, 2000, after carefully balancing the competing public and private interests, approved the decision of the Director of Public Works on September 22, 2000, and approved a Tentative/Parcel map which creates two new condominium units on the property located at 66-68 Fountain Street.
