On August 29, 2019, by Ordinance No. 179-19, the Board of Supervisors accepted Mission Bay Park P2 Parking Lot for City maintenance and liability purposes subject to the subsequent authorization from the Port of San Francisco Fire Marshal regarding required access to fire suppression connections for Port tenants.

As of February 4, 2020, I have approved the construction documents (B-2019-0204) necessary for the Port to issue permits for the extension of the dry standpipe and the installation of new hose valve outlet connections that are required to be located on the floating docks of Mission Creek Harbor intended for SFFD fire suppression activities for Port tenants. Accordingly, the date for City's acceptance of the Mission Bay Park P2 Parking Lot shall be February 4, 2020.
