





Second Amendment to the Operation and Management Agreement of Cable Car Museum 1201 Mason Street, San Francisco, CA 94108







- The SFMTA operates a cable car maintenance building including a cable car museum located at 1201 Mason St.
- On November 3, 2009, the Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution No. 432-09 which approved the Management and Operations Agreement between the SFMTA and Friends of the Cable Car Museum (FCCM) for a term of ten years with two 5-year extension options.
- As part of the Agreement, the Cable Car Museum provides free admissions to the general public and offers educational museum experience and guided tours. The Museum showrooms cable car related artifacts, a gift shop and observation deck overlooking winding wheels pulls cable car cables.
- On May 10, 2022, the Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution No. 191-22 to approve First Amendment to extend 5 years retroactive July 1, 2019 (first of the two 5-year extension options).







- Current First Amendment period term will expire on June 30, 2024.
- The SFMTA and FCCM wish to continue their relationship by exercising the second of the two 5-year extension options. This will provide consistency with respect to museum management, without schedule interruption, and continues to offer free visits and tours to city residents and tourists.
- On April 2, 2024, SFMTA Board of Directors adopted Resolution No. 240402-031 authorizing Director of Transportation of SFMTA to execute Second Amendment with FCCM for 5 additional years beginning July 1, 2024, thru June 30, 2029.



- The Second Amendment will bring in total Concession Fee of \$237,733 revenue for the SFMTA.
- We need your support and approval pursuant to Admin code: 9.118, which requires BOS approval for contracts, such as this, that exceeds 10 or more years term.
- With that approval the SFMTA can continue to provide the Museum and this transit experience to city residents, students, tourists and other visitors, free of charge.
