

1 [Accept-Expend State Grant]

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3 **Resolution authorizing the Chief of Police for the City and County of San Francisco to**  
4 **accept and expend grant funds made available through the Governor’s Office of**  
5 **Criminal Justice Planning for a project entitled “James Denman Middle School Safety**  
6 **Program” and waiving indirect costs due to funding constraint; rescinding Resolution**  
7 **Number 674-00.**

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9 WHEREAS, The Chief of Police of the City and County of San Francisco has  
10 undertaken a certain project designated “James Denman Middle School Safety Program”  
11 pursuant to Resolution Number 674-00, to be funded from funds made available through the  
12 Office of Criminal Justice Planning (herein referred to as OCJP); and,

13 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Police Department’s School Resource Officer program  
14 will implement a safety program at the James Denman Middle School to improve school  
15 safety, engage chronic truants in special programs and services to stay in school; and,

16 WHEREAS, The Department unknowingly omitted the need to backfill the position  
17 vacated through this program, and

18 WHEREAS, The Department proposes to maximize use of available grant funds on  
19 program expenditures by not including indirect costs in the grant budget due to funding  
20 constraints; now, therefore, be it

21 RESOLVED, That the Chief of Police of the City and County of San Francisco is  
22 authorized on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco to accept and expend continued  
23 funding for this project from OCJP, and waiving indirect costs due to funding constraints; and  
24 be it

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1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of  
2 indirect costs in the grant budget; and be it

3 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Chief of Police is authorized to execute on behalf of  
4 the City and County of San Francisco the necessary Grant Award Agreement for this project  
5 including any extensions, funding augmentations from OCJP, or amendments thereof; and be  
6 it

7 FURTHER RESOLVED, That it is agreed that any liability arising out of the  
8 performance of this Grant Agreement, including civil court actions for damages, shall be the  
9 responsibility of the grantee and the authorizing agency. The State of California and OCJP  
10 disclaim responsibility for and such liability; and be it

11 FURTHER RESOLVED, That grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to  
12 supplant expenditures controlled by this body, thus, the position vacated through this program  
13 will be backfilled contemporaneously with the same level of local funding by transferring  
14 equivalent funds from the Police Department’s uniform salary account to its overtime account  
15 for each fiscal year for the duration of this grant, and be it

16 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the department is requesting that resolution 674-00 be  
17 rescinded and replaced herein.
