8 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

9 Section 1. The San Francisco Park Code is hereby amended by amending Section
10 4.10, to read as follows:

11 **Sec. 4.10 ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES.**

12 (a) *Except as provided in Subsection 4.10(b), No* person shall consume alcoholic beverages of
13 any kind in any building, children's playground areas, swimming pool, restroom, ~~park that~~
14 ~~contains a children's playground or play structure,~~ or any of the *following* parks or portions of
15 parks: *as follows, except with the permission of the Recreation and Park Department.*

4 (b) The General Manager of the Recreation and Park Department or the Recreation and
5 Park Commission may grant permission to consume alcohol in the parks and portions of parks
6 where such activity is prohibited by Subsection (a), above, if the General Manager or the
7 Commission determines that the consumption of alcohol will not interfere with the public's use
8 and enjoyment of the park. However, neither the General Manager nor the Commission may
9 grant permission to consume alcohol in children's play areas.
