WHEREAS, In November of 1998 California Residents approved Proposition 10, The

PROPOSITION 10. THE CALIFORNIA CHILDREN AND FAMILIES INITIATIVE APPROVED

WHEREAS, This proposition created an additional \$.50 per pack tax on cigarettes and an equivalent increase on other tobacco products, estimated to generate an additional \$680 million in tax revenue per year; and

WHEREAS, Revenues from this increased tax are used to fund early childhood development and smoking cessation programs; and

WHEREAS, Proposition 10 revenue represents a major investment in early childhood development programs, an area that has been traditionally underserved; and

WHEREAS, Eighty-percent of the funds are directed to the local level for programs included in the county strategic plans developed and approved by county commissions whose members are appointed by the Board of Supervisors; and

WHEREAS, The other twenty-percent remains at the state level for expenditure under the direction of the California Children and Families State Commission for activities such as mass media communications, educational programs, research and development and child care programs; and

WHEREAS, Proposition 28 would repeal Proposition 10 and prohibit the imposition of any additional taxes on the distribution of cigarettes or other tobacco products unless enacted by the Legislature; and

WHEREAS, Proposition 28 would limit the ability of voters, through the initiative process, to establish further tax increases on tobacco products; therefore, be it
