DEFINITION



According to Section 103A.4.1, A building shall be defined as vacant or abandoned if it:

- is unoccupied and unsecured; or
- is unoccupied and secured by boarding or other similar means; or
- is unoccupied and unsafe as defined in Section 102 of the San Francisco Building

Code; or

- is unoccupied and has multiple code violations; or
- 5) has been unoccupied for over 30 days.

A building which is partially unoccupied and has been cited for blight under Chapter 80 of the S.F.






