Mr. Mayor, in your March appearance before the Board, I asked you about Proposition I, passed by voters in November 2007 to create an Office of Small Business that supports small businesses in complying with the laws administered by 14 City departments. Prop I specifically stated that within four months of the Office's opening, the Office "shall issue a report that analyzes the existing laws, regulations, roles, procedures and responsibilities of all City departments that impact small businesses and make recommendations regarding the streamlining and consolidation of such departmental functions under the Office of Small Business."

You committed that this report would be completed by June of this year. As of today, no report has been published and no overall recommendations have been made to streamline and consolidate the functions of the 14 different City departments from which 80,000 small businesses seek approvals to do business.

Mr. Mayor, I look forward to continuing to work with your administration on a wide variety of efforts to assist small businesses. Will you re-commit to carrying out this mandate of Prop I, and when will this report be forthcoming?
