4 **General Manager to set guest docking fees at the Marina Small Craft Harbor by flexible**  
5 **pricing based on certain factors; and affirming the Planning Department's**

14 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

15 Section 1. Environmental Findings.

16 The Planning Department has determined that the actions contemplated in this  
17 ordinance comply with the California Environmental Quality Act (California Public Resources  
18 Code Sections 21000 et seq.). Said determination is on file with the Clerk of the Board of  
19 Supervisors in File No. 190628 and is incorporated herein by reference. The Board affirms  
20 this determination.

21 Section 2. The Park Code is hereby amended by revising Section 12.11, to read as  
22 follows:

23 **SEC. 12.11. MARINA FEES.**

24 The following fees shall be charged for goods and services at the San Francisco  
25 Marina Small Craft Harbor:

1 \* \* \* \*

2 (d) **Guest Dock.**

3 (1) **Short Term Dock Fee** – \$1.50 per foot, per day.

4 (2) **Pick Up/Drop Off Fee** – \$2.50 per foot and \$1.00 per person, per day.

5 (3) **Flexible Pricing** – Notwithstanding the fees listed in subsections (d)(1) and (2), the  
6 Department General Manager or the General Manager’s designee may impose temporary increases  
7 and/or decreases to said fees, based on one or more of the following factors: fluctuations in customer  
8 demand at particular times or on particular days or dates or as among different areas of the Marina  
9 Small Craft Harbor, rates at comparable facilities, weather conditions, and dock conditions.

11  
12 Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after  
13 enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the  
14 ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board  
15 of Supervisors overrides the Mayor’s veto of the ordinance.

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1 Section 4. Scope of Ordinance. In enacting this ordinance, the Board of Supervisors  
2 intends to amend only those words, phrases, paragraphs, subsections, sections, articles,  
3 numbers, punctuation marks, charts, diagrams, or any other constituent parts of the Municipal  
4 Code that are explicitly shown in this ordinance as additions, deletions, Board amendment  
5 additions, and Board amendment deletions in accordance with the "Note" that appears under  
6 the official title of the ordinance.

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**LEGISLATIVE DIGEST**

[Park Code - Marina Guest Docking Fees]

**Ordinance amending the Park Code to permit the Recreation and Park Department General Manager to set guest docking fees by flexible pricing based on certain factors; and affirming the Planning Department's determination under the California Environmental Quality Act.**

Existing Law

The Park Code allows the Recreation and Park Department (RPD) to charge fees for use of the guest docks at the Marina Small Craft Harbor.

Amendments to Current Law

The proposed ordinance would allow RPD to impose temporary increases and/or decreases to the standard guest docking fees, based on one or more of the following factors: fluctuations in customer demand at particular times or on particular days or dates or as among different areas of the Marina Small Craft Harbor, rates at comparable facilities, weather conditions, and dock conditions.

Background Information

The rates codified in the Park Code are subject to annual cost-of-living adjustments by the Controller. This ordinance shows the codified rates and is not intended to invalidate any cost-of-living adjustments that the Controller has previously approved. The Recreation and Park Department maintains a list of the current rates. Currently, for use of the guest docks, the short term dock fee is \$2 per foot per day, and the pick up/drop off fee is \$3 per foot and \$1 per person, per day.



Notwithstanding the fees for short term dock fee at \$1.50 per foot, per day and pick up/drop off fee at \$2.50 per foot and \$1 per person, per day, the Recreation and Park Department General Manager, or the General Manager's designee, may impose temporary increases and/or decreases to the Marina Fees listed under Park Code, Section 12.11. The listed fees will be based on the following factors: fluctuations in customer demand at particular times, or on particular days, or dates, or as among different areas of the Marina Small Craft Harbor, rates at comparable facilities, weather conditions, and dock conditions.

In accordance with Administrative Code, Section 67.7-1, persons who are unable to attend the hearing on this matter may submit written comments to the City prior to the time the hearing begins. These comments will be made part of the official public record in this matter, and shall be brought to the attention of the members of the Committee.
