Resolution urging the California Public Utilities Commissioners not to authorize a multi-year Electricity Procurement for San Francisco Ratepayers.

WHEREAS, The California Public Utilities Commission will vote on December 19 whether to pre-approve Pacific Gas and Electric to resume multi-year electricity procurement and make all PG&E ratepayers responsible for repaying power contracts, resulting new non-by-passable surcharges that would directly block San Francisco from exercising its right to depart from PG&E electricity procurement pursuant to its 366.2 (c) (1) “authorization” to seek a new electric service provider, and in according to San Francisco ratepayers’ 366.2 (a)(1) “entitlement to aggregate and leverage negotiation of contracts with electric service providers; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco hereby urges the California Public Utilities Commissioners not to authorize a multi-year Electricity Procurement for San Francisco Ratepayers.




