

1 [Mayoral Reappointment, Entertainment Commission - Lieutenant Leonard Poggio]

3 **Motion approving/rejecting the Mayor’s nomination for the reappointment of Lieutenant**
4 **Leonard Poggio to the Entertainment Commission, term ending July 1, 2030.**

6 WHEREAS, Pursuant to Charter, Section 4.117, Mayor Daniel Lurie submitted a
7 communication notifying the Board of Supervisors of the nomination for the reappointment of
8 Lieutenant Leonard Poggio to the Entertainment Commission, received by the Clerk of the
9 Board on June 5, 2026; and

10 WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors has the authority to hold a public hearing and
11 vote on the appointment within sixty days following the transmittal of the Mayor’s Notice of
12 Appointment, and the failure of the Board of Supervisors to act on the nomination within the
13 sixty day time period shall result in the nominee being deem approved; and

14 WHEREAS, Charter, Section 4.117, requires that the member in seat 7 represent the
15 interests of the law enforcement community; now, therefore, be it

16 MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby approves/rejects the Mayor’s
17 nomination for the reappointment of Lieutenant Leonard Poggio, seat 7, succeeding himself,
18 to the Entertainment Commission, for the unexpired portion of a four-year term beginning July
19 1, 2026, and ending July 1, 2030.
