2 **Resolution declaring the results of the November 6, 2007 Municipal Election.**

3 WHEREAS, A Municipal Election was conducted in the City and County of San  
4 Francisco on Tuesday, November 6, 2007, which placed before the electorate candidates for  
5 Mayor, District Attorney, Sheriff, and City and County ballot measures; and,

6 WHEREAS, John Arntz, the Director of Elections of the City and County of San  
7 Francisco, has certified the results of the Municipal Election, a copy of which is contained in  
8 File No. 071646 of the Board of Supervisors, and which is incorporated herein by reference;
