WHEREAS, Field Research Corporation has revenues in the millions of dollars, only pays pennies above the minimum wage required by San Francisco law, and doesn't offer healthcare to the overwhelming majority of their employees; and

WHEREAS, Employees of Field Research have joined together to form a union to improve their wages, benefits and working conditions

WHEREAS, Field Research Corporation Management is in the process of interfering with their workers' efforts to have a collective bargaining rights by conducting anti-union "captive audience" meetings; and,

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Board of Supervisors has a long history of working to safeguard labor standards and employment rights of workers inside and outside of San Francisco; and,

WHEREAS, In recent years, and months the San Francisco Board of Supervisors has supported the passage minimum wage and health care legislation; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors hereby supports the rights of employees of Field Research Corporation to form a union and to bargain collectively; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors strongly condemns Field Research Corporation management's unethical actions to intimidate employees and calls on them to immediately stop interfering with their right to form a union.
