[Accept-Expend Bay Area Air Quality Management District Grant] AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKING AND TRAFFIC TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND A GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$250,800 FROM THE TRANSPORTATION FUND FOR CLEAN AIR IN THE BAY AREA FOR THE STRIPING OF BIKE LANES IN VARIOUS LOCATIONS AND WAIVING INDIRECT COSTS.

WHEREAS, Assembly Bill 434 created the Transportation Fund for Clean Air in the Bay Area, and provided authority to the Bay Area Air Quality Management District ("the District") to impose up to a \$4.00 surcharge on motor vehicle registration fees within its jurisdiction, to be used to implement specified transportation control measures; and.

WHEREAS, On October 16, 1991, the District approved a \$2.00 surcharge on motor vehicle registration fees, and raised the surcharge to \$4.00 effective April 1, 1993; and,

WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco supports the Bay Area Clean Air Plan; and,

WHEREAS, The Department of Parking and Traffic has developed a project for FY 1999-00 AB434 program funding to stripe bike lanes on the following streets:

7TH ST E SIDE, NB (TOWNSEND - BRYANT STS)

8TH ST W SIDE, SB (BRYANT - TOWNSEND STS)

14TH ST S SIDE, EB (GUERRERO - FOLSOM STS)

14TH S SIDE, EB (DOLORES - GUERRERO STS)

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors approved Resolution 615-99 on July 1, 1999, authorizing the Chief Administrative Officer to apply for grant support from the Transportation Fund for Clean Air in the Bay Area for programs and projects to reduce air pollution from motor vehicles, including this project, copy which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 99-1273; and,

WHEREAS, The Parking and Traffic Commission adopted Resolution No. 164-99-PTC at its meeting of September 7, 1999 authorizing the Executive Director of The Department of Parking and Traffic or his designee to execute documents necessary to apply for retroactively, accept and expend \$250,800 from the Transportation Fund for Clean Air in the Bay Area to stripe bike lanes in various locations; and,

WHEREAS calculating and claiming indirect costs using the methodology required by the District would require additional expense and reduce the funds available for program delivery; and,

WHEREAS, The Bicycle Advisory Committee, created by the Board of Supervisors, pursuant to Ordinance No. 365-90, has approved this project at their May 12, 1999 meeting; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Department of Parking and Traffic be authorized to accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$250,800, from the Transportation Fund for Clean Air in the Bay Area for the striping of bike lanes in various locations, waiving indirect costs.
