2 of the Department of Parking and Traffic to accept and expend state grant funds totaling
3 \$9,034,000 for various transportation capital projects in San Francisco.]

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5 **Resolution authorizing the Director of the Department of Public Works and the**
6 **Executive Director of the Department of Parking and Traffic to accept and expend up to**
7 **\$9,034,000 in state Regional Transportation Improvement Program (RTIP) Funds for**
8 **various transportation capital projects in the City and County of San Francisco.**

10 WHEREAS, S.B. 45 (Chapter 622, Statutes 1997) substantially revised the process for
11 estimating the amount of state and federal funds available for transportation projects in the
12 state for appropriating and allocating the available funds to these projects; and

13 WHEREAS, As part of that process, the Metropolitan Transportation Commission
14 (MTC) is responsible for programming projects eligible for Regional Transportation
15 Improvement Program (RTIP) funds, pursuant to Government Code Section 14527 (b), for
16 inclusion in the Regional Transportation Improvement Program, and submission to the
17 California Transportation Commission, for inclusion in the State Transportation Improvement
18 Program; and,

19 WHEREAS, MTC has requested eligible transportation project sponsors to submit
20 applications nominating projects to be programmed for RTIP funds in the 2002 Regional
21 Transportation Improvement Program; and,

22 WHEREAS, The San Francisco County Transportation Authority, acting as Congestion
23 Management Agency, has recommended the programming of a total of \$5,488,000 for the
24 Department of Public Works' (DPW's) Third Street/Bayshore Pavement Renovation Project;
25 and

1 WHEREAS, The San Francisco County Transportation Authority has recommended the
2 programming of a total of \$3,546,000 to fund the following projects put forth by the
3 Department of Parking and Traffic: 1) Addison & Digby Full Traffic Circle Construction Project
4 (\$230,000); 2) Phelan Avenue Crosswalk & Traffic Calming Improvements Project (\$200,000);
5 3) Ladder Crosswalk & Fluorescent Yellow Green Sign Installation Project (\$1,300,000); 4)
6 Traffic Signal Replacement Project (with Countdown and Audible Pedestrian Signals with
7 ADA-Accessible Pushbuttons - \$335,000); 5) Oak & Fell St. Integrated Traffic Management
8 System Deployment Project (\$1,271,000); 6) Laguna Honda & O'Shaughnessy Blvd. Path
9 Improvement Project (\$160,000); and 7) Median Refuge Island Accessibility Project
10 (\$50,000); and

11 WHEREAS, The State of California reimburses for certain indirect (administrative)
12 costs under the Regional Transportation Program; and

13 WHEREAS, Eligible indirect costs will be claimed at the applicable department rate;
14 and,

15 WHEREAS, There are no required local matching funds under the Regional
16 Transportation Improvement Program; now, therefore, be it

17 RESOLVED, That this Board of Supervisors does hereby authorize the Director of the
18 Department of Public Works and the Executive Director of the Department of Parking and
19 Traffic to accept and expend up to \$ 9,034,000 in Regional Transportation Improvement
20 Program funds for the aforementioned transportation capital projects and to execute any and
21 all documents necessary therefor.






