

Dear Ms. Calvillo:

Our office represents LandMark Retail Group ("Landmark"), the project sponsor of a proposed new CVS Pharmacy and convenience goods store located at 3132 Clement Street (the "Project"). On December 2, 2010, the San Francisco Planning Commission approved the Project. The approval permits the new CVS Pharmacy to operate between the hours of 7 a.m. to 10 p.m. daily.

CVS now seeks a type-20 off-sale beer and wine license from the California Department of Alcohol Beverage Control ("ABC"). LandMark has filed an application with ABC on behalf of CVS for a license transfer (License No. 508036). The license would be transferred from David's Food Store, located at 612 Kearny Street to the CVS Pharmacy at 3132 Clement Street. Due to the overconcentration of this type of ABC license in the census tract where the CVS Pharmacy will be located, CVS must obtain a determination by the Board of Supervisors that the public convenience and necessity will be served by the issuance of this license for operations at 3132 Clement Street.

The Project will establish a CVS Pharmacy at 3132 Clement Street in a building that was constructed in 2002 to house a full-service grocery store which included alcohol sales. An Albertsons Supermarket operated at the site up until 2006, but the site has sat vacant since. The CVS Pharmacy would occupy approximately 14,271 square feet at the southern end of the existing building. The exterior of the building and parking lot will be cleaned, repaired and repainted. The CVS Pharmacy would sell prescription drugs, over-the-counter drugs, beauty products and cosmetics, photo finishing, seasonal merchandise, greeting cards, and groceries (such as milk, bread and eggs), essentially replacing much of the goods and services that were once at this location when operated by the Albertsons Supermarket.

The Project will occupy and clean up a large building that has sat vacant for five years. The CVS Pharmacy will offer a wide variety of prescription drugs, groceries, and other

convenience goods in an area of the Richmond that is not well served by retail businesses. Adding beer and wine to the offerings of this CVS Pharmacy would serve the public convenience and necessity of the neighborhood by increasing the variety of goods offered at this store, which is located in an area that currently has a limited number of similar retailers. Area residents will have a new store that will be a convenient, safe and secure "one-stop" shopping experience for goods needed on a daily basis.

Adding beer and wine to the offerings of this CVS Pharmacy would serve the public convenience and necessity of the city of San Francisco by establishing a beer and wine retailer that has vast experience with the sale of alcohol and is a responsible retailer with an effective training and corporate-wide management policy for controlling the sale of beer and wine. CVS's employee training program, approved by the ABC, must be completed by all employees within 14 days of their hire and before they are permitted to operate the registers. CVS has a zero-tolerance policy – any employee knowingly or recklessly selling any age restricted product to a minor or to an adult purchasing product for a minor is subject to disciplinary action up to termination. Security cameras are equipped throughout the store and particularly in the area of beer and wine sales which are monitored by store management, regional loss prevention, CVS corporate, and can be made available to the police department upon request. All checkouts are equipped with electronic scan diction systems to control the sale of age restricted products and prompt cashiers to require proper identification before a sale is completed. CVS will continue to work with the San Francisco Police Department to ensure safe and responsible sale of beer and wine at this and all locations throughout the City.

For the reasons outlined above, I respectfully request that this letter be forwarded to the City Operations and Neighborhood Services Committee of the Board and that the Committee and the full Board of Supervisors make a determination under California Business & Professions Code §23958.4 that the public need or convenience would be served by the issuance of a type-20 off-sale beer and wine license to this CVS Pharmacy.
