2 AUTHORIZING THE COMMISSION ON THE AGING TO ACCEPT RETROACTIVELY AND EXPEND A
3 GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$201,696 FROM THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF
4 COMMUNITY SERVICES AND DEVELOPMENT FOR A NATURALIZATION SERVICES PROGRAM
5 BEGINNING MAY 1, 2000 AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2001.

6 WHEREAS the Commission on the Aging (COA) has applied for and been awarded a grant from the
7 State of California Department of Community Services and Development in the amount of \$201,696 to fund
8 the Naturalization Services Program, and;

9 WHEREAS this program will provide naturalization services including outreach, intake and
10 assessment, citizenship preparation, advocacy, and follow up through contracts with community based
11 nonprofit organizations, and;


12 WHEREAS in an effort to provide coordination and accountability to the naturalization effort, the COA
13 intends to standardize the services provided and to apply existing COA administrative, fiscal and
14 programmatic standards to naturalization services, and;

15 WHEREAS the entire amount of these funds will be used for direct service contracts without indirect
16 costs; therefore, be it



17 RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors authorizes the retroactive acceptance and expenditure of
