8 Section 1. Findings.

9 A. The Planning Department has determined that the actions contemplated in
 10 this Ordinance are in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (California
 11 Public Resources Code sections 21000 et seq.). Said determination is on file with the Clerk of
 12 the Board of Supervisors in File No. 110708 and is incorporated herein by reference.

13 Section 2. The San Francisco Health Code is hereby amended by amending
 14 Section 128, to read as follows:

15 Sec. 128. PATIENT RATES. (a) The Board of Supervisors of the City and
 16 County of San Francisco does hereby determine and fix the proper reasonable amounts to be
 17 charged to persons for services furnished by the Department of Public Health as follows,
 18 which rates shall be effective for services delivered as of ~~July 1, 2010~~ July 1, 2011.



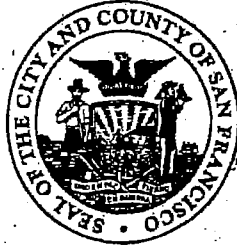
Existing Law
