Motion appointing Crystal Hawkins (residency requirement waived), term ending March 19, 2028, to the Child Care Planning and Advisory Council (District 10).

MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco does hereby appoint the hereinafter designated person to serve as a member of the Child Care Planning and Advisory Council, pursuant to the provisions of the Administrative Code, Article XX, Section 5.200, and Section 10.100-367, and California Education Code, Sections 8499.3-8499.7, for the terms specified:

Crystal Hawkins (residency requirement waived); seat 10, succeeding Jonathan Skolnick, term expired, must be a nominee of the District 10 Supervisor and represent one of the following categories: consumers, child care providers, discretionary, community representatives, or public agency representatives, for the unexpired portion of a three-year term ending March 19, 2028; and, be it

FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors makes the following findings:

- 1. The membership of the Child Care Planning and Advisory Council has a goal to be representative of the diversity of the City and County of San Francisco.
- Applicant Crystal Hawkins, who is not a resident of San Francisco, is a person with experience that uniquely qualifies them to serve on the Child Care Planning and Advisory Council.
- 3. The Child Care Planning and Advisory Council has attempted to fill the position, for which Crystal Hawkins was nominated, with an individual who is City a resident and who has the specific experience, skills, and qualifications, but has been unable to do so

1	at this time. The Rules Committee has certified that Crystal Hawkins is qualified to
2	serve on the Child Care Planning and Advisory Council.
3	4. After exercising due diligence, the Board of Supervisors concludes that there is no
4	other possible representatives who is a resident of San Francisco, who has the specific
5	experience, skills, or qualifications possessed by this applicant, and who is willing to
6	serve on the Child Care Planning and Advisory Council at this time; and, be it
7	FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors waives the residency requirement
8	for Crystal Hawkins, as is allowed in cases where no qualified City resident who is willing to
9	serve can be found, pursuant to Charter, Section 4.101(b), that otherwise requires person(s)
10	appointed to boards, commissions, and advisory bodies established by legislative act of the
11	Board of Supervisors to be resident(s) of the City and County of San Francisco.
