10 WHEREAS, Mark E. Renne is seeking a transfer of a Type 48 on-sale general
11 public premises liquor license from 2700-16th Street to 398 12th Street for Double
12 Rainbow, LLC, dba Roadhouse Tavern; and,

13 WHEREAS, The Planning Department has verified that the area is properly
14 zoned and recommends approval; now, therefore, be it

15 RESOLVED, That in accordance with Section 23958.4 of the California Business
16 and Professions Code, the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San
17 Francisco hereby determines for the foregoing reasons that the transfer of a Type 48
18 on-sale general public premises liquor license from 2700-16th Street to 398 12th Street
19 for Double Rainbow, LLC, dba Roadhouse Tavern, will serve the public convenience or
20 necessity of the people of the City and County of San Francisco.

21 Conditions: (1) Sales, service and consumption of alcoholic beverages shall be
22 permitted only between the hours of 11:00 a.m. and 2:00 a.m. daily. (2) No noise shall
23 be audible beyond the area under the control of the licensee(s) as defined on ABC-257.
24 (3) The sale of alcoholic beverages for consumption off the premises is strictly
25 prohibited. (4) Loitering (loitering is defined as "to stand idly about; linger aimlessly

1 without lawful business”) is prohibited on any sidewalks or property adjacent to the
2 licensed premises under control of the licensee as depicted on the ABC-257. (5) The
3 petitioner shall utilized electronic surveillance and recording equipment that is able to
4 view all exits and entrance points of the exterior of the premises. The electronic
5 surveillance/recording shall be operational at all times that the premises open to the
6 public. Said electronic recording shall be maintained and kept for a minimum of seven
7 (7) days, and shall be made available to Law Enforcement on demand. (6) Petitioner
8 shall not make structural changes in the premises interior without prior written approval
9 from the Department. (7) The licensee shall provide security as needed. Security
10 personnel shall be readily identifiable as security by wearing distinctive clothing that has
11 a logo of the establishment and the apparel shall state “SECURITY STAFF”. (8) The
12 exterior of the premises shall be equipped with lighting of sufficient power to illuminate
13 and make easily discernible the appearance and conduct of all persons on or about the
14 premises. Additionally, the position of such lighting shall not disturb the normal privacy
15 and use of any neighboring residences.

Honorable Supervisors,

My name is Seth Munter. I am here to ask you to TABLE this motion, and DELAY consideration by the board of supervisors.

Your action to TABLE is the ONLY way to bring all parties to the table for discussion.

I am a licensed Real Estate Salesperson in the State of California, and hold a Masters in Business Administration for UC Berkeley. I represent Mark Frazier, owner and operator of the Dallas Eagle. Over a year ago Mr. Frazier and I tried to approach the owner of 398 12th Street, John Nikitopoulos, to discuss a lease arrangement. Mr. Nikitopoulos made 2 demands before he would be willing to negotiate a lease:

1. All back rent (6 months at over \$8,000) would have to be paid by my client.
2. All repairs needed to bring the building to ADA compliance would have to be paid by my client

Let me be clear: Mr. Nikitopoulos would not DISCUSS a proposal without those requirements.

Working with Ron Hennis, past Manger of the SF Eagle Tavern, we ran financial analyses of 5 year business plans. The venture would be profitable were it not for Mr. Nikitopoulos' unreasonable pre-conditions.

Mr. Frazier made it clear he was interested in the Eagle. He asked to be called if Mr. Nikitopoulos changed his mind. My client left the door open to further discussions if anything changed. Mr. Nikitopoulos has NEVER called.

At that time I spoke with Supervisor Weiner, Supervisor Kim and Bevan Dufty, then a candidate for Mayor. We discussed working with Mr. Nikitopoulos to find a solution. His lawyer was unwilling to establish any dialog. I've been told that Mr Nikitopolous has not returned phone calls from Supervisor Weiner

This is unfortunate and unjustified. We deserve better from a landlord who has profited so long from the patrons of the SF Eagle Tavern.

When we learned of this transfer application, Mark Frazier and I contacted a number of community leaders who are willing to participate in these discussions. We believe that with community support, we can work with Alex _____ and Michael _____ to create a mutually beneficial agreement.

But Mr. Nikitopoulos has not responded to outreach and communication. But he has responded to pressure. He has responded to protests. He has ONLY responded when forced.

You have an opportunity to bring Mr. Nikitopoulos to the table. I'm not asking to deny the application. I'm not asking that we keep 398 12th Street vacant. But until YOU make it clear that the city expects the community to have a chance, an opportunity, to sit down with leaders and businessmen and hammer out a proposal, Mr. Nikitopoulos will continue to stonewall us.

We have the resources on our board of supervisors to mediate this issue. We have done this before with the Edge bar in The Castro. And with your help, mediation, and DIRECT PRESSURE, we can save the SF Eagle.

The ONLY way to bring all parties together is to TABLE this motion. So please... do NOT refer this proposal to the board for tomorrow's meeting, but POSTPONE consideration for one month so we can bring everyone involved together for a mutually beneficial solution.

Statement on the liquor license for the former Eagle Tavern

My name is William Baird. I live at 1370 De Haro Street. I have been a resident of San Francisco for 29 years.

I am the President of the San Francisco chapter of a club call the Defenders. We are a service organization, part of the leather-levi community, chartered by DignityUSA, which a national organization of LGBT Catholics. One of our primary purposes is to raise money for distribution to a variety of organizations. For our 18 years of existence, we typically have raise \$3,000 - \$4,000 a year; the primary source of fund-raising has been events at the Eagle. While we are looking at other sources of income, the loss of the beverage-benefits at the Eagle has been a major blow to our club, as well as to many other small not-for-profit groups in the City. Our lack of being able to distributed funds has impacted our beneficiaries, which range from the AIDS Emergency Fund to the Sojourn Chaplaincy at San Francisco Hospital to the Ronald MacDonald House for the families of hospitalized children.

In any transfer of a liqueur license for this premise, we ask that you consider the intent of the management for being supportive of the LGBT community by providing the means for **fund raising** using the unique character of the venue. Simply providing beverage services for sale to the community is not enough – there are many bars and restaurants that do that. The need is for partnering with a variety of organizations to generate income for those groups.

Henry:

As a co-founder (in 1987, along with Tricia James) of the South of Market Business Association /SOMBA, I am shocked and saddened to read your inaccurate and anti-business protest letter that was sent out on SOMBA's letterhead. As you know I do a great deal of ABC transfer work, and find your July 27, 2012 protest letter to be incorrect and misinformed.

First, by law, intra-county premises to premises transfers of ABC licenses are allowed. If the proposed license is a type- 48, 42, 40, 20 or 21, then a Public Convenience or Necessity determination must be passed by the Board of Supervisor or local governing body. That is the matter that is before the Board of Supes committee tomorrow at 9 am on the former Eagle Tavern.

You infer in your letter that per the SFPD, Mayor and Board of Supervisors, there can be no additional type-48 licenses in Southern District due to its "high density of bars". Wrong.

Please research:

-- **Board of Supes Res. 198-12** (file number No. 120080 Passed 5/22/12) whereby a Type-48 license was transferred into Southern District to **43 6th St.** from the Tenderloin.

I believe that you supported that new license and wrote a letter of support. [The Mayor is cutting the ribbon on that new bar, **Club OMG!**, 1 this coming Thursday.]

-- **Board of Supes Res. 0532-11** (file number No. 111074 Passed 12/5/11)) a new Type-48 was allowed at **691 Market Street** for **Local Edition**.

-- **Board of Supes Res. 577-10** (file number No. 101329 Passed 12/7/10) a Type-48 license was allowed to transfer onto **63 Jesse St.** from 730-732 Broadway Street.

-- **Board of Supes Res. 447-10** (file number No. 100834 Passed 12/7/10) a Type-48 license was allowed to double in size ("**intensification**") at **101 6th Street**.

-- **Board of Supes Res. 447-10** (file number No. 100834 Passed 12/7/10) a Type -47 license was converted to Type-48 and placed at **161 Erie Street** near 13th and Mission onto **Public Works**, a large dance club.

Type- 47 and Type-48 are both full-liquor ABC licenses. By law they are convertible from Type-48 to 47 or vice versa, upon payment of a \$100 conversion fee to ABC. I agree that

converting a Type-47 to a 48 is very tough in San Francisco because of SFPD protests. But it happens and it **is** possible. It only requires approval of SFPD and the Board of Supes.

In this case, the premises at 398-12 Street has held a Type- 48 bar license since at least the 1940's. It was an Irish longshoreman's bar [originally Buzz's Shamrock Tavern) longer than it was a leather/levi bar.

The original SF Eagle opened in 1980 and closed in 1997, and was an important gay institution that raised approximately \$3 million for HIV charities. In 1997 the SF Eagle business slowed and the bar was sold to the owners of the Hole in the Wall Saloon. These new owners renamed the bar the Eagle Tavern, got rid of the beer- bust fundraisers [later brought back due to community complaints], and got rid of the bare-chest fundraising calendar. The Hole in the Wall guys basically ran the business into the ground; They did not pay rent for the last six months of operation, and then refused to sell the Type-48 license to other gay owners who wanted to buy the place. There was a unlawful detainer eviction lawsuit pending against them when the stripped the bar in the middle of the night and left.

Don't believe me-- review the details of this sorry tale written by your associate, Glendon Hyde. Here is a link to Ana Conda's blog dated April 29, 2011.: <http://anarchondas.blogspot.com/2011/04/what-if-loosing-eagle-was-inside-job.html>. I confirms what I just wrote regarding the death of the Eagle in April 2011.

Mr. Hyde knew the real story of the Eagle's demise as of April 2011, but continued to spew anti-straight person rhetoric in order to rally the troops and stop any non-queer owner from taking possession of the business. Prejudice and discrimination is **always** wrong in my book, Henry. And you don't get a pass just because you are gay and trying to put a de facto deed-restriction on the property, that says only gay folk may own or lease certain property. I do hope that SOMBA stills believes in property rights.

The property at 398 -12th St. is owned by a trust that pays its income to a number of seniors who need that income to survive. They haven't had any rental income in approximately two years. The place has sat empty since April 2011-- 15 months. No jobs, no taxes to the city, no cool garden for the neighborhood folks to enjoy, and no Sunday fundraisers. The protest period on this pending application at ABC passed at the end of 2011. I don't see anything in your protest relevant to whether granting a new Type-48 license to this location serves or doesn't serve the public convenience of the citizens of San Francisco. The issue before the Board of Supes committee must be related to the public convenience-- and we believe that my letter requesting this PCN determination met our burden in showing how we will serve the

public convenience of the citizens of our City. This new operator will create approximately 35 jobs; they will create a beautiful urban garden with food and drink that is unique in Francisco; they will add a food component executed by extremely talented and successful food operators; they will clean up a blighted corner; reopen a failed/dead business; they will honor the history of the site; continue holding HIV fundraisers; and start paying City taxes. We have more than met our burden for a PCN, the SFPD agrees that we have met our burden, and the original committee vote on this matter was 3 to 0 in our favor. Not one person showed up to protest this transfer at the first duly-noticed hearing at the Board, nor were there any protests lodged with ABC during the official protest period [other than SFPD protest, which was removed after the client agreed to conditions on the new license.]

The applicants understand the extreme historical importance of this location. I lived in San Francisco Soma district during the entire 1983 to 1995 period, and I went to fundraisers at the Eagle. I say the horror show up close, and held dear friends in my arms and watched them die. Literally. **I get it.** I know what those \$1000 annual checks from the Aids Emergency Fund meant to friends who were dying, out of work and shunned by their family and friends. And I know how the leather guys were the **FIRST** people to step up to the plate, and do something about the nightmare. These guys changed the course of this horrible disease, they changed the course of history and the entire health-care delivery system in the US. The SF Eagle was ground zero in this story. I get it, and the proposed new operators get it.

What I **don't** get is how reverse discrimination is going to help anything. A dead space rotting away, another failed gay-owned following a failed business model, or a 85 ft. condo project at 398-12th Street in NOT a proper memorial for the generosity, and the valiant sacrifices made by patrons of the SF Eagle.

We need to talk.

This office represents Double Rainbow, LLC dba **Roadhouse Tavern**. My clients have applied to the California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) to transfer an On-Sale General Public Premises license to the premises at 398 – 12th Street, San Francisco, CA 94103-4330. This particular address has been licensed as a bar and nightclub since December 1980.

The previous owner operated this venue as the Eagle Tavern, a much-beloved institution in San Francisco's LGBT community and in the South of Market neighborhood. The location is unique in San Francisco and features a very large outdoor patio, garden and grilling area. There is also an outdoor stage which has historically featured local musicians and bands. This patio has hosted hundreds of fundraisers over the past three decades, primarily for HIV related charities.

After some 30 years the Eagle Tavern encountered financial problems and the previous owner closed the operation and removed their liquor license. The closing of the Eagle attracted a great deal of media attention. Unfortunately, much of what was reported was inaccurate and misstated the situation with the lease extension.

My client's family has owned the property for over 40 years and now wishes to place a new ABC license on the venue and reopen the business. It is our intention to maintain the spirit and layout of the location. We will upgrade the patio and the restrooms while maintaining the historic feel and charm of the business. During remodeling we will make the venue fully ADA compliant with new accessible bathrooms and other path-of-travel ADA upgrades. We will also add new soundproofing to insure the quiet enjoyment of nearby residences.

The Roadhouse tavern will continue hosting fundraisers with a special emphasis on LGBT and HIV charities. Besides these fundraisers it is my client's intention to support the local community with food drives, Christmas dinners and benefits for local charities and arts groups. We also intend to continue the much- beloved Thursday night live music events.

Given the historical importance of this business, and the value of this venue to the local music and LGBT community, we believe that its reopening will serve the local neighborhood as well as the larger San Francisco community and tourist economy. According to the California Arts Council, the Arts and Culture sector of the tourism industry in California tops \$17 billion in annual expenditures—one out of every four tourism dollars. San Francisco's tourist industry generates over \$6 billion and is the number one industry in the City. This venue has been and hopefully will be in the future a dynamic part of our culture and tourism industry.

The reopening of this business at 398- 12th Street will add approximately 30 jobs to the San Francisco economy, as well as continuing sales tax revenue for the City. The large outdoor patio will be a valuable resource to the neighborhood and to San Francisco entertainment community. This location, with its large walled outdoor patio and sunny inner-Mission climate, is unique and different from any other bar, lounge or nightclub in San Francisco. The applicant is open to the imposition of conditions to address any community or law enforcement concerns.

The approval by the Board of Supervisors of this ABC License would not have any detrimental effect on the surrounding neighborhood or the city of San Francisco. Historically, the clientele of this operation fit well into the existing neighborhood and has posed no public safety problems in the past. The Eagle Tavern has been a good neighbor and positive influence in the neighborhood and The Roadhouse Tavern will likewise be a good neighbor and an asset to the community.

For the reasons outlined above, applicant Double Rainbow, LLC dba **Roadhouse Tavern** respectfully request that this letter be forwarded to the City Operations and Neighborhood Services Committee of the Board and that this Committee and the full Board of Supervisors make a determination under California Business and Professions Code § 23958.4 that the public need or convenience would be served by the issuance of a Type-48 liquor license to **Roadhouse Tavern** at 398- 12th Street

Bio

Co-founder of Foreign Cinema restaurant, Bruce McDonald is a restaurateur with a broad business background. Mr. McDonald started his career in hospitality as a dishwasher, prep cook and busboy in high school before leaving the industry and pursuing a career in software engineering and management consulting. He earned a BA in Engineering Sciences from Dartmouth College, spent 5 years working software development which included several years in Japan where he became fluent in Japanese, tasting sake and eating sushi. Mr. McDonald returned to academia and earned an MBA from Northwestern University's Kellogg School of Management. He then spent the next five years working in management consulting for Booz Allen and Hamilton working on projects that spanned all industries and disciplines. This experience left him feeling rewarded but exhausted and ultimately thought there was something better in his future.

In 1999, Mr. McDonald joined forces with two other visionaries in the restaurant industry and opened Foreign Cinema to wide critical acclaim. Foreign Cinema has been ranked among the top 50 restaurants in the Bay Area by Michael Bauer of the San Francisco Chronicle every year it has been open. A year later they opened Laszlo, a successful DJ bar adjacent to Foreign Cinema. Mr. McDonald took control of the operation in 2001 when 9/11 and a lagging economy strained the business and has successfully run it along with chef/partners Gayle Pirie and John Clark since that time.

Recently Mr. McDonald and chefs Pirie/Clark opened Showdogs, an emporium of sausages, beer and other casual foods at the corner of 6th Street and Market Street in San Francisco. Again, the critics have raved about the house made sausages and condiments.

Mr. McDonald was also quoted recently in the Wall Street Journal about his experience opening Foreign Cinema:

"Entrepreneurs who've done their homework and have faith in their business plan may feel comfortable pressing ahead with a risky location, even if the landlord or owner of the space expresses doubts.

Bruce McDonald, co-owner of the Foreign Cinema restaurant in San Francisco's gritty Mission District, founded the establishment in 1998, leasing space that previously had high turnover, including some month-to-month tenants.

The owner of the building, Colleen Meharry, says she leveled with Mr. McDonald about the previous occupants, whose enterprises included a used-clothing store and a taco stand. "They were just lousy operators. They just looked good to me as long as they paid the rent."

Ms. Meharry says she had doubts about Mr. McDonald's business plan: wooing an upscale clientele with \$30 entrees, a sophisticated atmosphere and foreign films projected in a central courtyard—all in one of the city's worst quarters. "Your car was more likely

to be stolen than valet-parked in that neighborhood back then," Ms. Meharry says. "There was a lot of crime."

True, says Mr. McDonald. But all of that had a certain appeal for the kind of customer he envisioned, he says. "I know that to be considered cool, some restaurants benefit from being in an area that's edgy," he says. "The fact that the neighborhood was a little bit rough was more positive than negative. So going into a place that hadn't been successful actually helped us."
