

1 [Presidio Neighborhood Representative Work Group]

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3 **Resolution re-establishing the Presidio Neighborhood Representative Work Group to**
4 **be comprised of representatives from affected neighborhoods and City Departments.**
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7 WHEREAS, The Presidio Trust has begun the process of changing the Presidio Trust
8 ~~Master~~ Management Plan (PTMP), *last adopted in May of 2002*; and,

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10 WHEREAS, The Presidio Trust is anticipated to release the draft Supplemental
11 Environmental Impact Statement (SEIS) containing an analysis of the environmental impacts
12 of developments proposed at the Presidio in early June 2008; and,

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14 WHEREAS, The City and members of the public will be given an anticipated 45 day
15 period to comment on the changes to the Presidio Trust ~~Master~~ Management Plan and draft
16 Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement; and,

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18 WHEREAS, The development in the Presidio ~~and changes thereto~~ could have a
19 tremendous impact upon the City's infrastructure and the demand for City services; and,

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21 WHEREAS, The development of the Presidio could have a tremendous impact upon
22 the neighborhoods surrounding the Presidio, especially with regard to traffic, transit, congestion,
23 parking and the impacts directly outside all of the Presidio gates; and,

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25 *WHEREAS, The Presidio and Golden Gate National Parks provide benefits to the City and
County of San Francisco by protecting and managing the parklands which provide open space for
recreation, education, and the enjoyment of wildlife at no cost to residents of the City and their visitors;*
and, now, therefore, be it

1 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors does hereby re-establish the Presidio
2 Neighborhood Representative Work Group, which shall be subject to the mandates of the
3 Sunshine Ordinance; and, be it

4 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Planning Department shall compile a report
5 containing commentary to the Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement and Presidio
6 Trust ~~Master~~ Management Plan of The Presidio Neighborhood Representative Work Group
7 which shall be presented to the Board of Supervisors City Operations and Neighborhood
8 Services Committee; and, be it

9 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City Attorney shall assist the Planning Department in
10 compiling Work Group commentary on the Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement
11 and Presidio Trust ~~Master~~ Management Plan and in formulating the commentary for the report
12 to be submitted to the Board of Supervisors City Operations and Neighborhood Services Committee
13 and subsequently to the Presidio Trust Board or Directors and Presidio Trust NEPA Compliance
14 Officer; and be it

15 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Presidio Neighborhood Representative Work Group
16 shall include the following representatives and alternate representatives designated by the
17 following groups

18 ~~two~~ one representatives from the Neighborhood Associations for Presidio Planning
19 (NAPP) selected by NAPP,

20 -one representative of the Cow Hollow Association selected by Cow Hollow
21 Association,

24 -one representative of the Marina-Cow Hollow Neighbors and Merchants to be
25 selected by the Marina-Cow Hollow Neighbors and Merchants,

1 -one representative of the Pacific Heights Residents Association selected by the
2 Pacific Heights Residents Association,
3 -one representative of the Planning Association for the Richmond selected by the
4 Planning Association for the Richmond,
5 -one representative of the Presidio Heights Neighborhood Association selected by the
6 Presidio Heights Neighborhood Association,
7 -one representative of the Lake Street Residents Association selected by the Lake
8 Street Residents Association,
9 -one representative of the Laurel Heights Improvement Association selected by the
10 Laurel Heights Improvement Association,
11 -one representative of the Sea Cliff Properties Association selected by the Sea Cliff
12 Properties Association.
13 -one representative of the Golden Gate Valley Neighborhood Association selected by
14 the Golden Gate Valley Neighborhood Association,
15 -one representative of the Sierra Club selected by the Sierra Club,
16 -one representative of the Marina Merchants Association selected by the Marina Merchants
17 Association,
18 -the department heads or their designees from the Public Utilities Commission, the Municipal
19 Transportation Authority, Department of Public Works, Transportation Authority, Planning
20 Department, Controller, City Attorney, Mayor's Office of Neighborhood Services, and Mayor's Office
21 of Economic and Workforce Development; and be it
22 FURTHER RESOLVED, The Office of the City Administrator shall implement any legally
23 required public notice and shall help administer the work group; and be it
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1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Presidio Neighborhood Representative Work Group shall
2 begin meeting immediately in order to develop the City's commentary on the Presidio Trust
3 Management Plan and Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement; and, be it

4 FURTHER RESOLVED, That this Work Group shall develop a report on the costs associated
5 and the impacts of future planning actions by the Presidio Trust; and, be it

6 FURTHER RESOLVED, That this Work Group shall report any of its findings, concerns or
7 recommendations to the Board of Supervisors during and beyond the 45-day comment period on the
8 Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement.
