WHEREAS, In December 2004, the Board of Supervisor’s created the Arts Task Force under Resolution No. 781-04, a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 041621 and is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as it set forth fully herein; and,

WHEREAS, In May 2005, the Arts Task Force was extended to August 1, 2005 to submit it’s final report to the Board of Supervisors under Resolution No. 316-05; a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 050703 and is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as it set forth fully herein; and,

WHEREAS, In its year and a half of existence, the Arts Task Force has a membership representative of City Departments, artists and nonprofit community groups working with Artists, as well the larger and smaller budgeted arts organizations; and,

WHEREAS, The establishment of the Arts Task Force has been beneficial to the City of San Francisco and will result in the establishment of a coordinated delivery system for the Arts in San Francisco; and, now therefore be It

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby extends the operations of the Art Task Force, as described in Resolution No. 781-04, through January 31, 2006, and that if additional time is required, a written request to the Board of Supervisors for a resolution extending the Task Force’s Operation will be required.
