WHEREAS, \$800,000 sits in an account that could be used for the building of a Bessie Carmichael Elementary School that was never claimed by Superintendent Rojas; and,

WHEREAS. This type of shoddy financial management is what is being investigated; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors urges Superintendent Bill Rojas to cooperate fully with all investigations into mismanagement during his tenure, and to respond truthfully to all questions asked.
