

1 [Grant Application - Retroactive - Centers for Disease Control and Prevention - High-Impact  
2 HIV Prevention and Surveillance Programs for Health Departments - \$5,909,395]

3 **Resolution retroactively authorizing the Department of Public Health to submit an**  
4 **application to continue to receive funding for the High-Impact HIV Prevention and**  
5 **Surveillance Programs for Health Departments grant from the Centers for Disease**  
6 **Control and Prevention; and requesting \$5,909,395 in HIV Emergency Relief Program**  
7 **funding for the San Francisco Eligible Metropolitan Area for the period of August 1,**  
8 **2024, through May 31, 2025.**

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10 WHEREAS, San Francisco Administrative Code, Section 10.170., requires Board  
11 review of proposed annual or otherwise recurring grant applications of \$5,000,000 or more  
12 prior to their submission; and

13 WHEREAS, Department of Public Health (DPH) is currently a recipient of the “High-  
14 Impact HIV Prevention and Surveillance Programs for Health Departments” grant in the  
15 amount of approximately \$5,909,395 from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention  
16 (HRSA) for Fiscal Year 2025; and

17 WHEREAS, For this round of funding, DPH was instructed by HRSA to submit an  
18 application request in the amount of \$5,909,395; and

19 WHEREAS, DPH uses these funds to cover a multitude of health services to HIV  
20 positive persons residing in the three counties within the San Francisco Eligible Metropolitan  
21 Areas; and

22 WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 265-05 requires that City Departments submit applications  
23 for approval at least 60 days prior to the grant deadline for review and approval; and

24 WHEREAS, HRSA released the application guidance on February 9, 2024, with a due  
25 date of April 29, 2024, allowing 80 business days for the entire process; and

1           WHEREAS, In the interest of timeliness, DPH is making this request for approval by  
2 submitting its most recent draft of the grant application, also including supporting documents  
3 as required, all of which are on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File  
4 No. 240988, which is hereby declared to be part of the Resolution as if set forth fully herein;  
5 now, therefore, be it

6           RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby approves DPH's application  
7 submission to HRSA for the "High-Impact HIV Prevention and Surveillance Programs for  
8 Health Departments" grant for the funding period of August 1, 2024, through May 31, 2025, to  
9 be submitted no later than April 29, 2024.
