

[Public Employment and Accept-Expend Federal Grant – Amendment to the Annual Salary Ordinance, FY 2007-2008. Mayor’s Summer Food Service Program and After School Snack Program - 2008.]

Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 175-07 (Annual Salary Ordinance 2007-2008) to reflect the addition of one position (0.40 FTE) 9774 Sr. Community Development Specialist, one position (0.40 FTE) 1840 Jr. Management Assistant, and thirteen positions (1.04 FTE) 9910 Public Service Trainee in the Department of Children, Youth and Families (CHF), and authorizing the department to accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$950,710, currently and retroactively, if necessary, from the United States Department of Agriculture to sponsor the 2008 Mayor’s Summer Food Program and the After School Snack Program.

Section 2. Authorization to Accept and Expend Funds.

The United States Department of Agriculture provides funds to the City and County of San Francisco to operate the Summer Food Service Program. The funding will provide children ages 0 – 18 with free lunches during the summer months from June to August 2008. An average of 5,000 children will be served lunch each day during the summer at approximately 100 sites throughout the City. The United States Department of Agriculture has created a pilot Year-Round Feeding program to provide reimbursement funding for sponsors to provide after school snacks for children.

1 Funding from the Year-Round Feeding Program will enable the City and County of San
2 Francisco's After School Snack Program to provide children with free snacks through
3 50 After School program sites, providing an average of 1500 children per day with a
4 nutritious snack during After School hours. The terms of the grant prohibit indirect
5 costs. Therefore, this ordinance hereby waives inclusion of indirect costs in the grant
6 budget.
