WHEREAS, All individuals have the right to protect themselves through accessing, possessing and utilizing safer sex strategies including condoms; and

WHEREAS, It is harmful to public health efforts to in any way deter persons from possessing and utilizing condoms; and

WHEREAS, The practice of confiscating, photographing or otherwise using the possession of condoms as evidence of a person's intent to engage in prostitution effectively deters the possession and use of condoms thereby increasing their risk of HIV transmission; and

WHEREAS, The public health cost of criminalizing condoms and thereby deterring their use is found to be greater than the cost of finding alternative evidence in prostitution arrests: now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors supports the prohibition of using condoms as evidence of prostitution; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors supports and encourages the passage of Assembly Bill 336.
