Please find attached a proposed resolution for Board of Supervisors approval that would adopt a Participation Agreement between the County of San Francisco and California Mental Health Services Authority (CalMHSA) for the San Francisco Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) Innovation Program entitled "Technology Assisted Mental Health Solutions".

The Mental Health Services Act was passed in 2004 through a ballot initiative (Proposition 63) and provides funding to support new and expanded county mental health programs. By regulation, a portion of this funding must be spent on Innovation programming. The Technology Assisted Mental Health Solutions Innovation Project was developed with stakeholder input, posted for 30-day public comment, and approved at a Public Hearing of the SF Behavioral Health Commission, as required by the State to access MHSA funding. The County Board of Supervisors approved of the project plan before its submission to and approval by the State Mental Health Services Oversight and Accountability Commission (MHSOAC) on September 27, 2018. The County Board of Supervisors approved the transfer of funds to CalMHSA for project administration for three years on June 14, 2019. The attached resolution approves the transfer of funds to CalMHSA for project administration for a total project duration that lasts no longer than ten years.
