This is to notify you that a petition signed by property owners to renew a property and business improvement district in your area, known as the Dogpatch and Northwest Potrero Hill Green Benefit District, was received by the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors on 4/29/2025.

If this Property and Business Improvement District is renewed, it would authorize assessments against real property in the district for 15 years with services to be implemented January 1, 2026, through December 31, 2040. The Dogpatch and Northwest Potrero Hill Green Benefit District would fund and provide the following services:

- 1) Maintenance;
- 2) Capital Improvements;
- 3) Accountability, Transparency, and Citizen Services; and
- 4) Operations and Contingency/Reserves.

Renewal of the property and business improvement district is subject to the approval of the Board of Supervisors after a noticed public hearing and a vote by the property owners who would be subject to the assessments. Following public comment, ballots submitted by property owners in the proposed Dogpatch and Northwest Potrero Hill Green Benefit District will be counted by the Department of Elections and the results will be announced by the Board of Supervisors. If the ballot election does not result in a majority protest against renewal of the proposed district, the Board of Supervisors may vote to renew the Dogpatch and Northwest Potrero Hill Green Benefit District.
