WHEREAS, Glenn began his work in the epidemic in 1984 as a test-result counselor in the San Francisco Men's Health Study, the first San Francisco organization to do HIV testing before such tests were made available for general use; and,

WHEREAS, Glenn served for many years on the board of the San Francisco AIDS Foundation, and was its president from 1988-1990; and,

WHEREAS, Glenn has been the Executive Director of Continuum, the Tenderloin-based service agency, since 1993; and,

WHEREAS, Under Glenn's leadership, the agency's budget has grown to over \$2 million; and,

WHEREAS, While Glenn was Executive Director, the agency successfully sued Medi-Cal which has subsequently funded persons with HIV disease accessing adult day health care (ADHC); and,

WHEREAS, During his tenure, Continuum expanded from its core ADHC program to include a State of California-funded Nurse Case Management program and inaugurated the innovative Tenderloin Cares program in early 1997; and,

WHEREAS, Continuum has recently been awarded an Integrated Services Contract which brings the agency into the top tier of organizations serving San Franciscans with HIV disease; and,

WHEREAS, Because of Glenn, Continuum is able to continue serving the most underserved of those impacted by the epidemic; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors honors Bill Glenn for his many years of dedication, vision and compassion and for achieving his goals with grace and humor; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco commends his many accomplishments at Continuum and as a leader in the AIDS epidemic.
