Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the ordinance unsigned or does not 24 25

sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board of Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.

(b) This ordinance shall become operative the day after the California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) publishes on its website either (1) a list of the 2018 results of the drawing pursuant to California Business and Professions Code Sections 23826 and 23961 to determine the priority in which ABC will consider the 2018 applications for neighborhood-restricted special on-sale general liquor licenses, or (2) if no drawing is conducted, a list of persons eligible to apply for a neighborhood-restricted special on-sale general liquor license in 2018.
