

1 [Appointment, Sunshine Ordinance Task Force - Jaya Padmanabhan]

3 **Motion appointing Jaya Padmanabhan (residency requirement waived), term ending**  
4 **April 27, 2021, to the Sunshine Ordinance Task Force.**

6 MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco does  
7 hereby appoint the hereinafter designated persons to serve as a member of the Sunshine  
8 Ordinance Task Force, pursuant to the provisions of Administrative Code, Section 67.30, for  
9 the terms specified:

10 Jaya Padmanabhan (residency requirement waived), seat 4, succeeding Pixie (Rishi)  
11 Chopra, resigned, must be nominated by the local chapter of the Society of Professional  
12 Journalists and be either a journalist from a racial/ethnic-minority-owned news organization, a  
13 journalist whose work focuses on issues impacting minority racial or ethnic communities, or a  
14 journalist who works with a media organization or publication whose target audience is a  
15 minority racial or ethnic community. For purposes of this subsection (a), the term “journalist”  
16 shall be interpreted broadly, including but not limited to freelance journalists, photographers,  
17 and videographers, for the unexpired portion of a two-year term ending April 27, 2021; and, be  
18 it

19 FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors makes the following findings:

- 20 1. The membership of the Sunshine Ordinance Task Force has a goal to be  
21 representative of the diversity of the City and County of San Francisco.
- 22 2. Applicant Jaya Padmanabhan, who is not a resident of San Francisco, is a person with  
23 experience that uniquely qualifies them to serve on the Sunshine Ordinance Task  
24 Force.

1 3. The Sunshine Ordinance Task Force has attempted to fill the position, for which Jaya  
2 Padmanabhan was nominated, with an individual who is a City resident and who has  
3 the specific experience, skills, and qualifications, but has been unable to do so at this  
4 time. The Rules Committee has certified that Jaya Padmanabhan is qualified to serve  
5 on the Sunshine Ordinance Task Force.

6 4. After exercising due diligence, the Board of Supervisors concludes that there is no  
7 other possible representatives, who is a resident of San Francisco, and who has the  
8 specific experience, skills, or qualifications possessed by this applicant, and who is  
9 willing to serve on the Sunshine Ordinance Task Force at this time; and, be it

10 FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors waives the residency requirement  
11 for Jaya Padmanabhan, as allowed in cases where no qualified City resident, willing to serve,  
12 can be found, pursuant to Charter, Section 4.101(a)(2), that requires person(s) appointed to  
13 boards, commissions, and advisory bodies established by legislative act of the Board of  
14 Supervisors to be resident(s) of the City and County of San Francisco.
