[Settlement of Lawsuit - David Alfaro, et al. - \$3,626,444.85]

Ordinance authorizing final settlement of the lawsuit filed by David Alfaro, et al. against the City and County of San Francisco for \$3,626,444.85; the lawsuit was filed on August 20, 2015, in San Francisco Superior Court, Case No. CGC-15-547492; entitled <u>David Alfaro</u>, et al. v. City and County of San Francisco; the lawsuit involves inverse condemnation arising out of flooding damage during major rainstorms in December of 2014; this settlement relates only to the claims for statutory attorney's fees, costs and interest and completely resolves the litigation.

Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

Section 1. Pursuant to Charter Section 6.102(5), the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the City Attorney to settle claims for statutory attorney's fees, costs and interest as to all Plaintiffs and completely resolves the action entitled <u>David Alfaro</u>, et al. v. City and <u>County of San Francisco</u>, San Francisco Superior Court, Case No. CGC-15-547492 by the payment of \$3,626,444.85 to plaintiffs and their counsel. The lawsuit involves inverse condemnation arising out of flooding damage during major rainstorms in December of 2014.

Section 2. The above-named action was filed in San Francisco Superior Court on August 20, 2015. This is an action brought by owners or occupants of several dozen properties located in San Francisco against defendant City and County of San Francisco.

Section 3. This is the final piece of a three-step settlement of the action. It resolves all claims for statutory costs, interest, and attorney's fees due to all Plaintiffs. The parties have previously, separately settled the personal and real property damage claims of all property owners and diminution in value claims of all property owners in this action (see Board
