URGING THE CALIFORNIA STATE LEGISLATURE AND GOVERNOR DAVIS TO

APPROVE SENATE BILL 48 REVISING THE CALIFORNIA PUBLIC RECORDS ACT

WHEREAS, The California Public Records Act provides that the records of state and local agencies, unless exempt, should be made available upon payment of fees to cover costs; and,

WHEREAS, The California Public Records Act requires each agency to determine within 10 days from the receipt of a request for records whether the request seeks disclosable records within the possession of the agency and to notify the person making the request of that determination and the reasons therefor; and,

WHEREAS, The California Public Records Act authorizes persons to institute judicial proceedings to enforce his or her right to inspect or receive a copy of any public record; and,

WHEREAS, Persons have continued to face difficulties in their attempts to inspect or copy disclosable public records under the California Public Records Act; and,

WHEREAS, The California State Legislature is currently considering Senate Bill 48, which was introduced by Senator Sher; and,

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 48 would provide that any person who is notified of a denial of a request for public records may appeal to the Attorney General within 15 days of the date of the denial; and,

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 48 would require the Attorney General to issue a written decision within 15 days of the date that the written request and written response of the agency is received by the Attorney General; and,

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 48 would require the Attorney General to fine an agency \$100 per day for illegally withholding documents; and,

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco endorses Senate Bill 48 and urges the California State Legislature to approve this legislation; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be forwarded to his Honor, the Mayor, with a request that he transmit copies to the delegation from San Francisco, as well as Governor Davis, with a request they take all action necessary to achieve the objectives of this resolution.
