6	WHEREAS, The Asian Art Museum of San Francisco has served as a public institution
7	whose mission is to lead a diverse global audience in discovering the unique material,
8	aesthetic and intellectual achievements of Asian art and culture for nearly 40 years; and,
9	WHEREAS, The Asian Art Museum's collection contains more than 15,000 art objects,
0	spanning 6,000 years of history, and representing countries and cultures throughout Asia; and,
1	WHEREAS, The Asian Art Museum uses its resources to "Make Asia Accessible" to a
2	diverse and rapidly expanding Asian-descendent populace that searches for meaningful and
3	comprehensible introduction to its cultural heritage; and to a non-Asian populace who wish to
4	be introduced to traditions and cultures that now play an increasingly prominent role in
5	American life; and,
6	WHEREAS, The museum has become a major venue in the Bay Area for Asian
7	performing arts and film, and attracts the involvement of the Asian community in the planning
8	and implementation of programs;
9	WHEREAS, The Asian Art Museum has drawn nearly 400,000 visitors since
