

1 [Study of at-risk and HIV positive youth in San Francisco.]

3 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (DPH), to enter**
4 **retroactively into an agreement in the amount of \$26,851 with the University of**
5 **California (UCSF), the primary contractor, to participate in a study of at-risk and HIV**
6 **positive youth in San Francisco, for the period of March 1, 2006 to February 28, 2007.**

8 WHEREAS, UCSF is the recipient of a grant award from the National Institutes of
9 Health (NIH) for the conduct of a program titled “A San Francisco Street Youth Cohort: At-Risk
10 and HIV+”; and,

11 WHEREAS, It is considered in the best interest of NIH, UCSF, and DPH to participate
12 in this project; and,

13 WHEREAS, UCSF has agreed to reimburse DPH in the amount of \$26,851 under the
14 terms of this agreement; and,

15 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the funds UCSF requires DPH to enter into a
16 subcontract (the “Agreement”), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of
17 Supervisors in File No. _____, which is hereby declared to be a part of this
18 resolution as if set forth fully within; and,

19 WHEREAS, Resolutions authorizing the acceptance and expenditure of grant funds
20 may be placed automatically on consent agendas in committee, as they are usually
21 considered to be routine items, and this resolution authorizes the acceptance and expenditure
22 of grant funding; and,

23 WHEREAS, The contract budget includes provision for indirect costs of \$2,441, now
24 therefore be it

1 RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to enter retroactively into a subcontract
2 agreement in the amount of \$26,851 with UCSF, the primary contractor, for services under the
3 program entitled “A San Francisco Street Youth Cohort: At-Risk and HIV+”; and, be it

4 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the
5 agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it

6 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate all positions
7 funded under this agreement as “G” or grant-funded positions which would terminate when
8 the agreement expires.
