SUPPORTING THE CONTINUED MANAGEMENT OF THE GOVERNMENT CABLE ACCESS CHANNEL, CITYWATCH, BY THE NONPROFIT CORPORATION KNOWN AS THE SAN FRANCISCO COMMUNITY TELEVISION CORPORATION (CTC), AND URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF TELECOMMUNICATIONS AND INFORMATION SERVICES (DTIS) TO

CONTINUE THE PERSONAL SERVICES CONTRACT WITH CTC TO PROVIDE

MANAGEMENT SERVICES.

WHEREAS, The Community Television Corporation created the government cable access channel in 1993, at the request of the Board of Supervisors and the Mayor, and has maintained and managed the channel successfully since that time; and,

WHEREAS, The CTC has provided the leadership, vision and expertise resulting in the development of cable television facilities at the Emergency Command Center, the Main Library, the War Memorial Building and City Hall; and,

WHEREAS, The CTC's nonpartisan, nonprofit management and oversight of the channel shields the City from conflicts of interest and other liability issues; and,

WHEREAS, The CTC is positioned to provide shared management of both the public and government channels, as well as management of shared public, education and government (PEG) channel resources such as a mobile production van and the proposed PEG television facilities in the Mayor's Center for Advanced Technology (MCAT); and,

WHEREAS, The CTC is able to acquire quickly and maintain equipment, provide the mechanism for private fund raising for the channels and provide Broadcast and other liability insurance; and,

WHEREAS, The City has created the position of Executive Producer to oversee City personnel and union issues and to work with the CTC to coordinate with City departments and develop programming for the channel; and,

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors does not support any single City department's having management and content control over the channel; and

WHEREAS, The CTC's contract to manage the channel expires on June 30, 1999; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors supports the continued management of the government cable access channel, CITYWATCH, by the nonprofit corporation known as the San Francisco Community Television Corporation (CTC); and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors urges the Department of Telecommunications and Information Services to continue the personal services contract with CTC to provide management services and to submit a contract for this purpose to the CTC for its approval and signature by June 30, 1999.
