  - 2) Request for authorization for the Mayor and Director of MOHCD to execute documents in furtherance of this resolution
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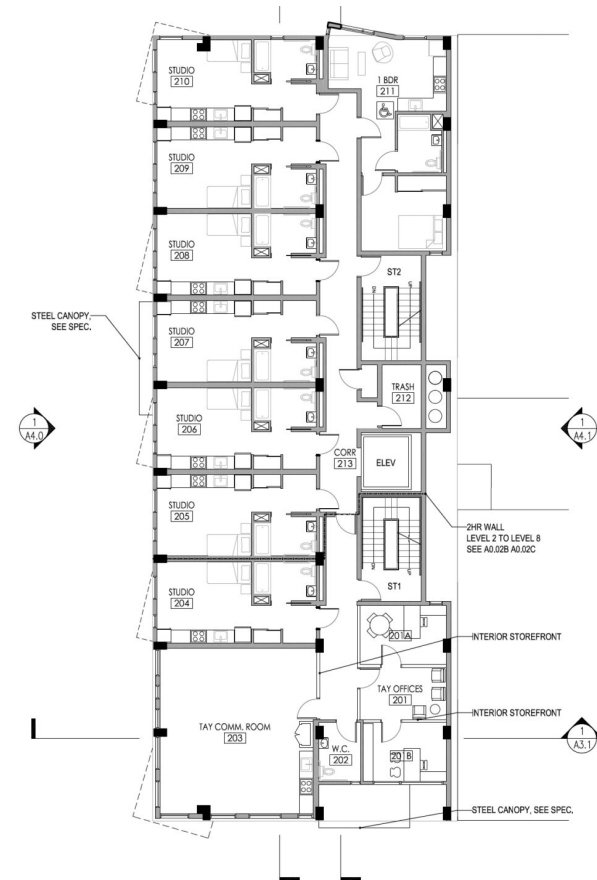
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## PROJECT



- 64 affordable units
  - 58 studios
  - 5 one-bedroom units
  - 1 three-bedroom family childcare unit
- Target Populations
  - 32 units for homeless and at-risk transitional age youth
  - 31 lottery units
- AMIs range from 30% to 65% MOHCD AMI
- Supportive housing units for Transition Age Youth require an operating subsidy
- Start of construction: 2022
- Project completed: September 2025

# Request for Operating Subsidy LOSP and NPLH COSR

## 32 TAY supportive housing units require an operating subsidy

- Local Operating Subsidy Program funds are proposed at \$10,589,361 over 15-year term
- No Place Like Home (NPLH) Capitalized Operating Subsidy Reserve (COSR) is proposed at \$4,780,000 over 20-year term
- The Project has capital NPLH funding (state funds awarded to MOHCD), and the proposed leveraging of additional NPLH COSR funds for the 15 NPLH units reduces the burden on the LOSP General Fund
