1 [Recommending Electrification and Essential Rehabilitation of  
2 CalTrain]

3 RECOMMENDING THAT THE PENINSULA CORRIDOR JOINT POWERS BOARD DECLARE  
4 ELECTRIFICATION AND ESSENTIAL REHABILITATION FOR SAFE OPERATION OF  
5 THE TRAINS OF THE ENTIRE CALTRAIN SYSTEM A TOP PRIORITY OF THE REGION  
6 AND URGING THE PENINSULA CORRIDOR JOINT POWERS BOARD TO SEEK PROMPT  
7 AND COST EFFECTIVE IMPLEMENTATION OF THIS PRIORITY.

9 WHEREAS, Electrification and system rehabilitation of CalTrain  
10 has been studied extensively over the past several years; and,

11 WHEREAS, The studies demonstrate that electrification and system  
12 rehabilitation would provide significant benefits to the speed,  
13 operating costs and attractiveness of the CalTrain system; and,

14 WHEREAS, Electrification and system rehabilitation would  
15 contribute to significant reductions in air pollution in San  
16 Francisco and on the Peninsula; and,

17 WHEREAS, Ridership originating from the San Francisco station is  
18 the fastest growing segment of the CalTrain ridership; and,

19 WHEREAS, The San Mateo County Transportation Authority has  
20 substantial funding set aside for major CalTrain improvements; now,  
21 therefore, be it

22 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors recommends that the  
23 Peninsula Corridor Joint Powers Board declare electrification and  
24 essential rehabilitation for safe operation of the trains of the  
25 entire CalTrain system a top priority of the region; and, be it


