2 Corrections - Officer Wellness and Mental Health Grant Program - \$1,407,675.74]

3 **Resolution retroactively authorizing the Police Department to accept and expend a**  
4 **grant in the amount of \$1,407,675.74 from the California Board of State and**  
5 **Community Corrections Officer Wellness and Mental Health Grant Program to**  
6 **improve officer wellness and expand mental health sources for our sworn members**  
7 **with the project period beginning on July 1, 2022, through December 1, 2025.**

9 WHEREAS, The Administrative Code requires City departments to obtain Board of  
10 Supervisors' approval to accept or expend these grant funds (Section 10.170 et seq.); and

11 WHEREAS, The California Board of State and Community Corrections provided this  
12 grant to law enforcement agencies to support mental health and well-being; and

13 WHEREAS, On March 3, 2023, the Police Department received a check in the  
14 amount of \$1,407,675.74 to improve officer wellness and expand mental health sources for  
15 our sworn members; and

16 WHEREAS, The grant does not require an Annual Salary Ordinance Amendment;  
17 and

18 WHEREAS, Because the entire award of the Officer Wellness and Mental Health  
19 Grant Program will be used to improve officer wellness and expand mental health sources  
20 for our sworn members, it is requested that indirect costs be waived to maximize use of  
21 available grant funds on the program expenditures by not including indirect costs in the  
22 grant budget; now, therefore, be it

23 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors retroactively authorizes the Police  
24 Department to accept and expend the grant of \$1,407,675.74 from the California Board of  
25 State and Community Corrections; and, be it

1           FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of  
2 indirect costs in the grant budget; and, be it

3           FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Chief of  
4 Police, or his designee, to enter into the agreement on behalf of the City and County of San  
5 Francisco.


